

Northeast Partners in Amphibian and Reptile Conservation (NEPARC)

Community Conservation Award

Nomination Information

About the Award: This Award is presented by Northeast Partners in Amphibian and Reptile Conservation (NEPARC) to recognize an individual who has made a considerable contribution(s) to the conservation of amphibians and reptiles in a particular state or geographical area in the NEPARC region. The award recognizes someone who works with partners to advance herpetofaunal conservation efforts at a state- or local-level where achievements have contributed to preventing the loss of species or their habitats or has educated others to further the NEPARC mission.

The recipient is presented with the award at the Annual Meeting of NEPARC, which is typically held each July or August. Recipients are awarded registration and free lodging and meals for this meeting, as well as a plaque commemorating the award.

Award Criteria:

Nominees may be submitted by third parties or self-submitted, and must meet the following criteria:

1. Any person who has displayed exemplary commitment to building or strengthening partnerships at the state- or local-level, particularly with stakeholders outside the individual's organization or with non-traditional stakeholders that further the mission of NEPARC.
2. Special consideration will be given to any person who has exhibited tenacious effort, leadership and professionalism in a manner that is inspiring to their peers, and who has been overlooked by other means of acclaim.
3. Nominees need not be current members of the NEPARC organization and current members of the NEPARC Steering Committee (SC) are not eligible for nomination.

Nominations:

The NEPARC co-chairs make a call for nominations prior to the annual meeting and distribute information about the award including the attached nomination form. The NEPARC SC will review nominations and conduct an anonymous vote to select a recipient. The award will only be given out in years where at least one qualified applicant is received, but one award maximum per year will be given.

5. Please provide a brief (not to exceed one page) CV for the nominee, and any supplemental information (not to exceed one additional full page). Supplemental information may be a brief biographical sketch, or a letter of recommendation, that illustrates the nominee's long-term efforts, leadership and professionalism. (Please limit to two pages total.)
